

from the thigh down and at time he died he so
badly swollen it was necessary to tape him
before they could get him into his coffin
he died suddenly from heart failure - he had
been able to creep about up to within an
hour of his death for about two years
before he could not work and could
only creep around he was very weak
and swollen. I have applied for the
accrued pension that was due my husband
at time of his death but have not yet received
it. he was pensioned at \$6. per month for
about 2 years before he died.

I have applied for pension as his widow
under the law of Act of June 27. 1890.
