

ACT OF FEBRUARY 6, 1907.  
DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 5<sup>th</sup> day of September, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and Seven, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Frank Tyler, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he 69 years of age, and a resident of Glenwood county of Howard, State of Maryland; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Washington D. C. under the name of Frank Tyler on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1863 as a private, in Capt. Henry Ward Company (D.) 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment of Md. Colored Troops in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Roanoke Island, on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1865. That he also served.....

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 5 inches; complexion, Black; color of eyes, Black; color of hair, Black; that his occupation was Laborer; that he was born in Howard Co. Md., 18... at near Glenwood

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: Has since his discharge always lived in Howard County Maryland, near Florence

That he is..... a pensioner. That he has..... heretofore applied for pension..... Pension No. 457,010

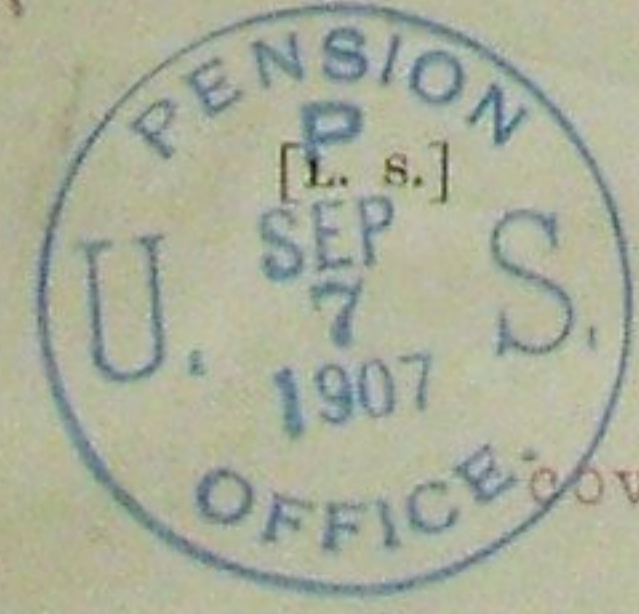
That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.
