Sir:

Please furnish this Office a report of hospital treatment in the Claim No. 418, H. O. of Frank Taylor, late a Private Co. "D" 1st W. B. T. I., from the data given below.

1. Disability from gun shot wound of left shoulder received from the enemy's ranks while entering upon Embankment in front of Petersburg Va, during summer of 1864

2. Treatment, as follows: at City Point Hospital for three months. Please examine the records of Regt. Dev. Corps & all other hospitals likely to afford evidence as to treatment for the alleged or other wounds or injuries.

The claimant can furnish no further information as to date of receiving wound, or hospital treatment, or name or number of hospital or location, further than that it was across the river, in the rear of the Centurion.
