a Justice of the Peace in and for the City and State
aforesaid, personally appeared Oliver Cromwell

who, being duly sworn, testifies as follows:

I am 46 years of age and reside at
No 2111 Christian St. street, Baltimore, Md.,
and I have no interest in the claim above quoted.

I am the claimant and in my application
for pension under Act of June 27-90 I claimed
pension for Varicose veins, lung, heart and head
trouble. I have suffered ever since the war
with Chronic Diarrhoea and piles which I
had at discharge and which I failed to ap-
ply for in my original application - also deaf-
ness the result of malarial fever soon after discharge.
I now ask to amend my application to
include the diarrhoea and piles - and deaf-
ness. I was sick with Chills and fevers for
22 months just after discharge and my
head trouble and deafness followed this at-
tack.
