



The Hessian fly can be controlled largely by late planting, rotation of crops and not allowing volunteer wheat to grow on fallow ground. The treatment is essentially one in which Order of Publication the host plant is kept away until the last fall egg-laying brood of the insect has disappeared. The date of its disappearance depends on the latitude, altitude and weather conditions. A wet September may cause an early disappearance, while a long fall drought and warm weather may cause a much later disappearance. 


