Most of the citizens of Kent will rejoice that the effort to change the appointment of Road Engineer from the County Commissioners to the Governor, failed of passage at Annapolis. As stated several weeks ago, this would have been a backward step.

The General Assembly of Maryland adjourned Monday night. It is at this time impossible to state just what was done. Few local bills were passed, we understand, and they have not been acted upon by the Governor.

By using his veto on several appropriation bills, Governor Ritchie succeeded in keeping the Democratic pledge for a lower tax rate. Thank you, Governor.

The marriage bill, which would have virtually abolished Maryland's notorious "Gretna Green," where hundreds of eloping couples and divorced persons have hastily united every year and no questions asked, was killed in the Legislature over protests of the delegation from Cecil county, where Elkton is located.

This company will contract for about 400 acres of tomatoes this year. Next year Mr. Hartlove says he hopes to can string beans and various other crops.

The Harris Cannery is one of the best equipped plants in the county.

PREPARING TO CAN ASPARAGUS
The cannery at Fredericktown is preparing to can asparagus this year and thus relieve the farmers of their grass when the market in the cities are low. This cannery makes a specialty of sugar corn paying \$13 per ton last year. This year they are offering \$18. They also can tomatoes.

The Middletown cannery is also preparing to can asparagus and will pay 15, 20 and 25 cents per bunch according to quality.

H. N. Baldwin, the reputable proprietor of the Chestertown cannery, is thinking seriously of equipping his plant so as to handle asparagus next year. This would be a great help to farmers as there have been many acres of asparagus planted recently.

Dairymen of Worton Save Industry There!

Delegation Visit Headquarters in Philadelphia Saturday—Dealers Decide To Continue Plant—Production To Be Increased.

A delegation of dairy farmers from Worton went to Philadelphia last Saturday and presented the following resolution to the Supplee-Wills-Jones Company:

We, the undersigned milk producers of Kent County, Md., and patrons of Worton Milk Receiving Station, of Supplee-Wills-Jones, do protest against the closing of the Worton Milk Receiving Station. We further protest that the order to close our receiving station came without warning and without reason for same. If the reason in the minds of the Supplee-Wills-Jones Company officials for closing the Worton Receiving Station is based upon the quantity of milk received or an irregular supply throughout the year, we hereby signify our sincere intention to increase the quantity of milk and will endeavor to produce a more uniform quantity of milk throughout the year. We are all planning to adhere to the Sanitary Milk Regulations with the right spirit. (Signed by 82 patrons.)

After hearing the pleas of the delegation the Creamery Company decided to continue the plant and make Norman Cooper, supervisor. Mr. Wallis has gone to Harrington as superintendent of a new plant. Last month as announced in the News the company issued orders closing the station, but the situation among the farmers and merchants of that section of the county "was so desperate that the Philadelphia concern listened to the appeals of the delegation and will allow the station to remain in operation. The closing of this station, which is the oldest in the county, would have worked a hardship upon the farmers and resulted in the loss of thousands of dollars worth of business to the merchants of that town who have depended largely upon the trade of the farmers to maintain their business. It is of interest to know the amount of milk received at the four stations on the Kent railroad, as follows:
