CONVENIENT GEAR SHIFT ARRANGEMENT

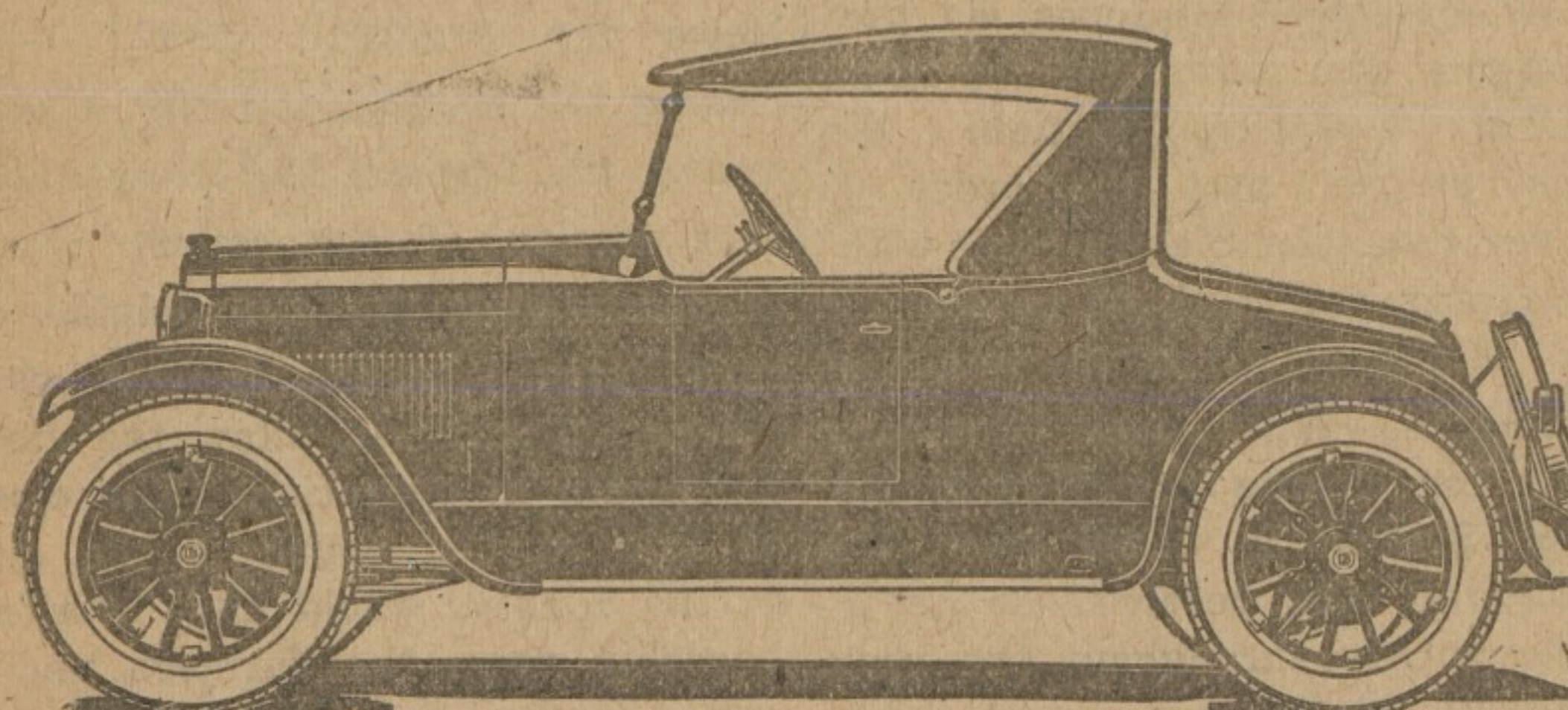
The hand gear shift lever has been moved forward, thus allowing easy access to the driver's seat. The throw of this lever has been shortened to facilitate easy gear shifting, while a strong spring prevents the lever from rattling on its seat. A lock built in the transmission locks the gears in the neutral position. This lock has been approved by the Underwriters' Laboratories.

ATTRACTIVE STEERING WHEEL AND HAND CONTROL

The steering wheel is of moulded fibre construction and holds the spider firmly without the aid of screws. The spark and hand levers are shorter, conveniently located, and are retained by friction on a handsome nickel quadrant. The horn wire is now carried inside the steering column.

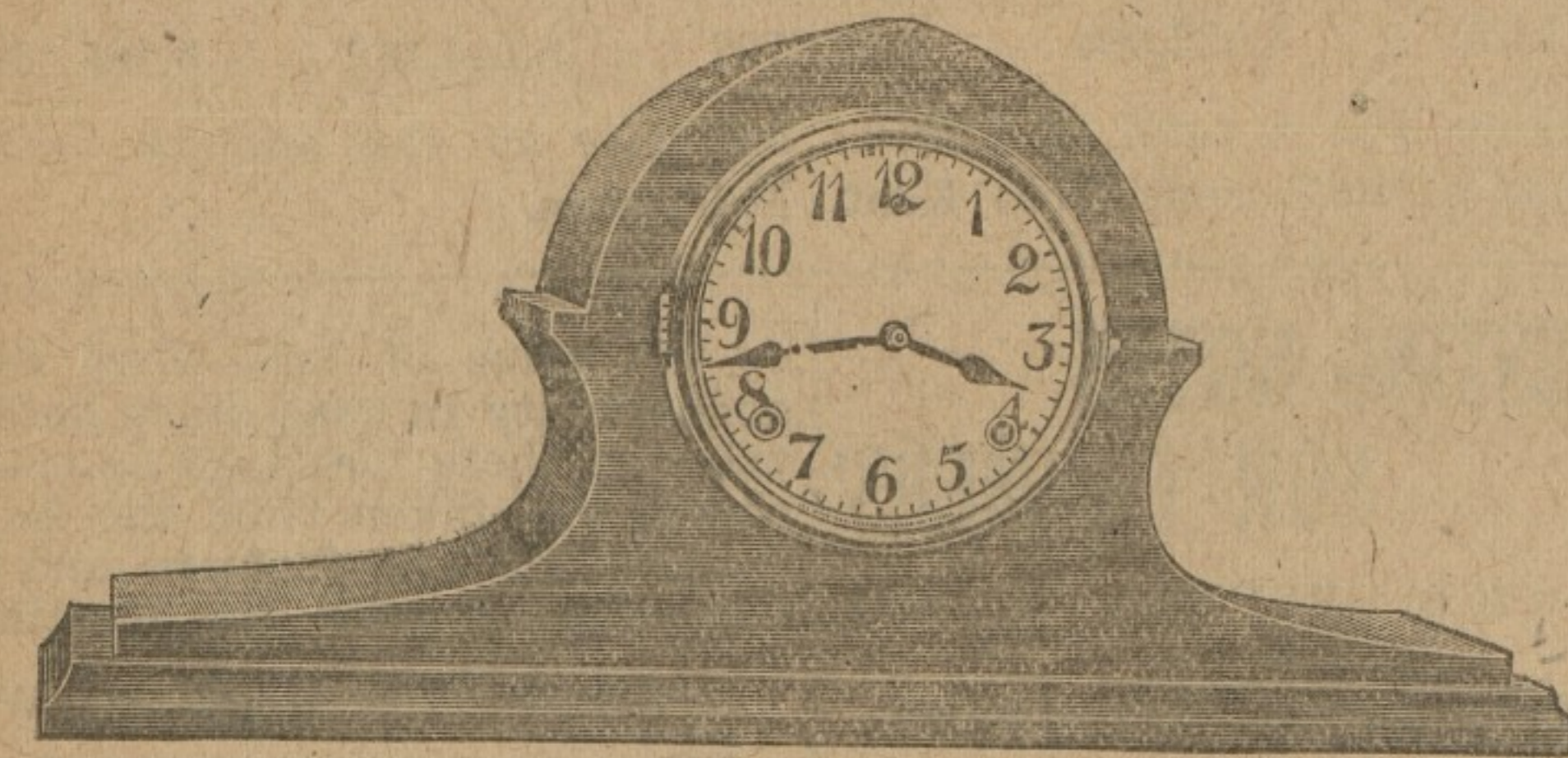
ACCESSIBLE BRAKE CONTROL

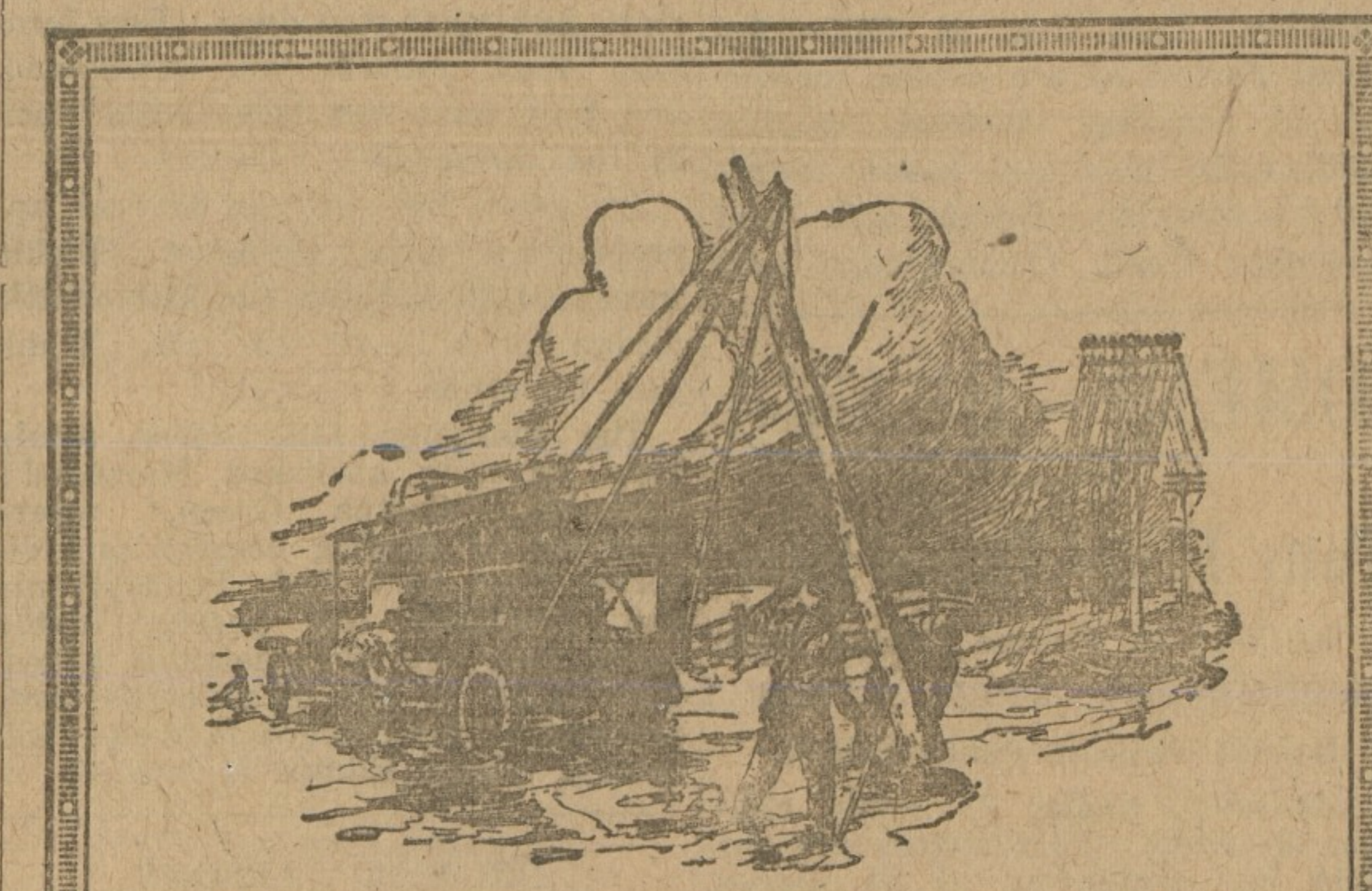

CAMPAIGN FOR COLLEGE GAINING MOMENTUM

Washington College \$250,000 Endowment Fund Campaign is gaining momentum each week now that the preliminary stages have been passed and the Kent County Campaign is under way. The quota assigned to Kent County by the executive committee is \$25,000 and of this sum, approximately \$10,000 was reported at the first meeting of the committee Tuesday evening in Reid Hall on the Campus and on every hand was expressed a spirit of optimism that the county quota would be secured by April 8th. The Faculty and employees of the college, not to be outdone by the students, subscribed 100 per cent and these subscriptions will be included in the Kent County totals. Other sections of the Eastern Shore are making rapid progress. Cecil County will begin its intensive effort

this week and conclude before April 15th when it is expected the county quota of \$10,000 will have been secured. Associated with Irving T. Kepler and Albert D. Mackey and Hugh W. Caldwell, Mrs. Guy Johnson, Rev. J. R. Rowleson, D. Ralph Andrews, Edward J. Campbell, Jos. Coudon, J. C. Riepe, Frank W. Clapp and James M. Holden as a county committee, representing the various centers in the county. Salisbury alone has accepted a quota of \$10,000 and will also begin work this week and with adjacent territory in the county, expects to add to this amount as Wicomico County's share of the fund. President Paul E. Titworth, of the college expressed himself as well pleased with the splendid spirit being shown by citizens up and down the Eastern Shore, particularly as they are organized to carry through in their various centers, their part in the program. Said Dr. Titworth, "I am confident that as our people realize fully the value of Washington College to the community, there will be whole hearted response. Having a college on the Eastern Shore means that more of our young friends will get a college education than otherwise for approximately two-thirds of former Washington students would have missed a college education entirely if it had not been for Washington College. We owe this same opportunity to the children of this and coming generations. One reason for this is that our boys and girls on the Eastern Shore can be educated at Washington College approximately one-half what it would cost parents to send them elsewhere. It is unthinkable that the citizens of the Eastern Shore will fail in this challenge from the State because the college is a great asset, giving us better trained leaders in all activities, —the professions, business, farming, home and government. Washington College also is a wealth producer practically 75 per cent of the wealth of the nation is created through the initiative and resourcefulness of college trained men and women. For instance, surveys made in New York and Indiana show that college trained farmers earned 2.6 times as much as those having a common school education only. Then again statistics gathered over a long period of years show that in the business world, 80 per cent of the college men make good as against 25 per cent of non-college men and it is known that while the college trained represent less than 2 per cent of our population these 2 per cent produce 72 per cent of the men and women whose accomplishments qualify them in listing Who's Who, the blue book of Producers of American Life. We, the Eastern Shore, wish our children to have the same opportunity that children living elsewhere have. The only sure way to do it is to build up what is distinctly our own and our only college—Washington."

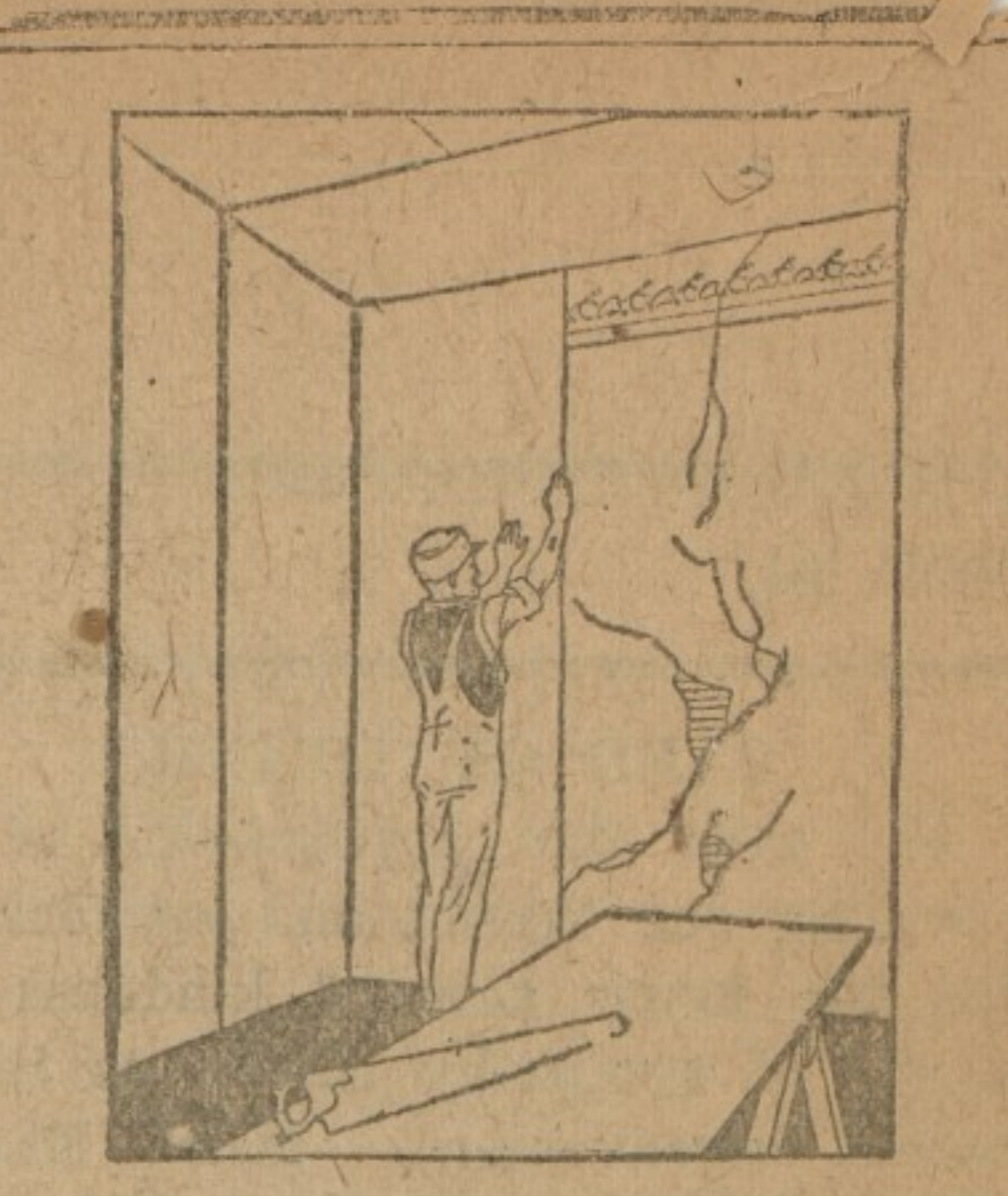

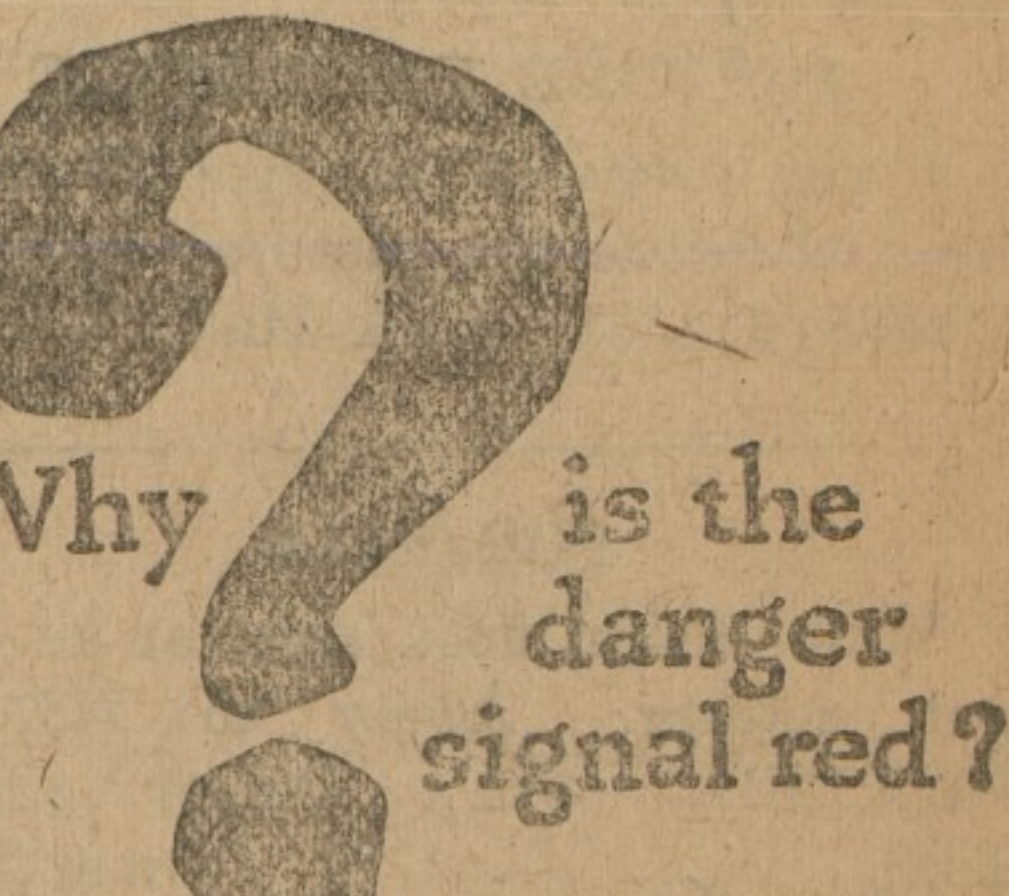
