DEPREDAATIONS BY DOGS

The depredations of worthless dogs upon the farmers' sheep and poultry throughout the county cost the Board of County Commissioners between \$1,400 and \$1,500 during the year just closed, because of a legislative enactment which requires the Commissioners to pay a subsidy for the destruction of farmers property by dogs. The expense has become so great that the Commissioners determined to make a systematic survey of the county in order to round up all dogs found at large without the necessary license tag which is to be supplied by constables for each of the seven districts to be appointed by the Commissioners. These constables are being appointed as fast as the men can be inducted to accept. There are at present in the Commissioners' office claims amounting close to \$1,100 awaiting adjustment.

Other counties are taking the same steps. For instance in Montgomery the County Commissioners have fixed a schedule of maximum amounts to be allowed for injury or destruction by dogs to live stock and poultry of residents of the county. It is as follows: Each horse, \$100; cow, \$80; ewe or ram, \$12; lamb, \$8; goat, \$10; sow, \$15; pig, \$3; turkey, \$5; turkey hen, \$6; young turkey hen, \$3; geese, \$2; duck, \$1; chicken, \$2. The law directs that such damage allowed are to be paid out of the fund from the sale of dog licenses.

DEATH OF DR. PARVIS

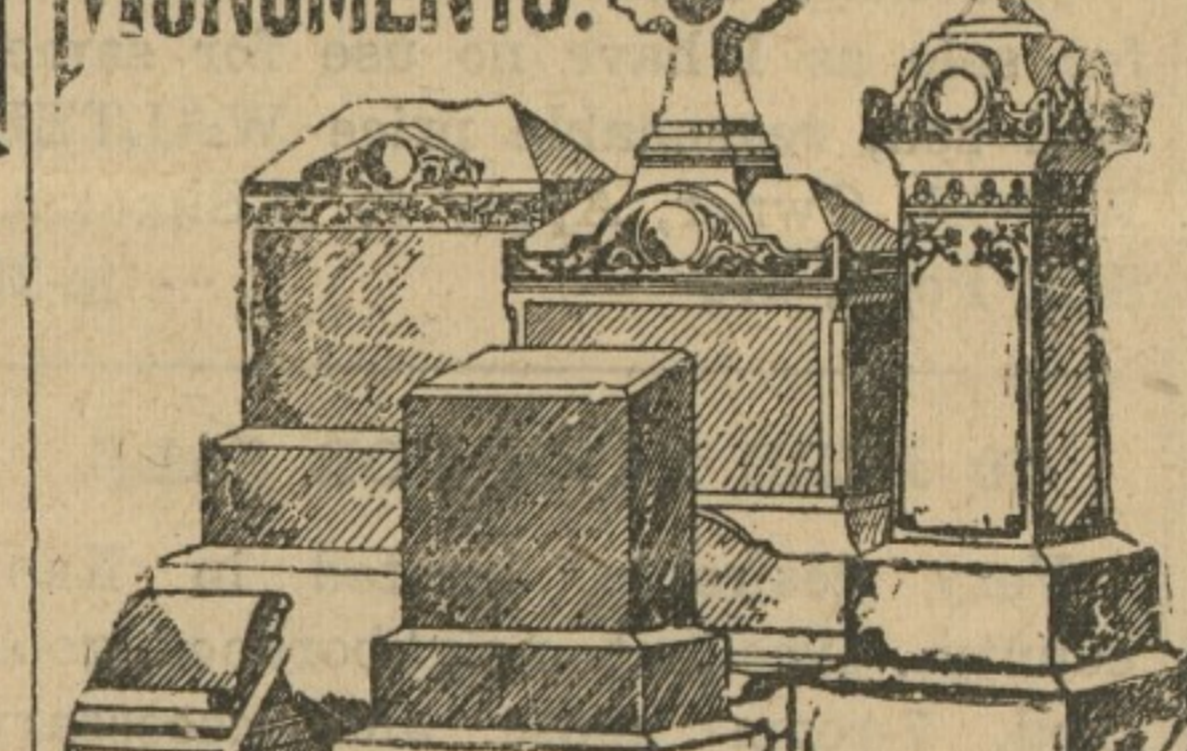
Dr. William A. Parvis, well-known in Upper Kent, noted physician and surgeon of Socorro, New Mexico, died Tuesday, May 27th, at a hospital in New Mexico where he had gone for special treatment. He was 44 years old and a son of Mrs. Lida Hopkins Parvis, who also lived in Socorro. Mrs. Parvis kept a boarding house near the Rennett Hotel in Baltimore for many years. Dr. Parvis graduated at Maryland University in 1905. 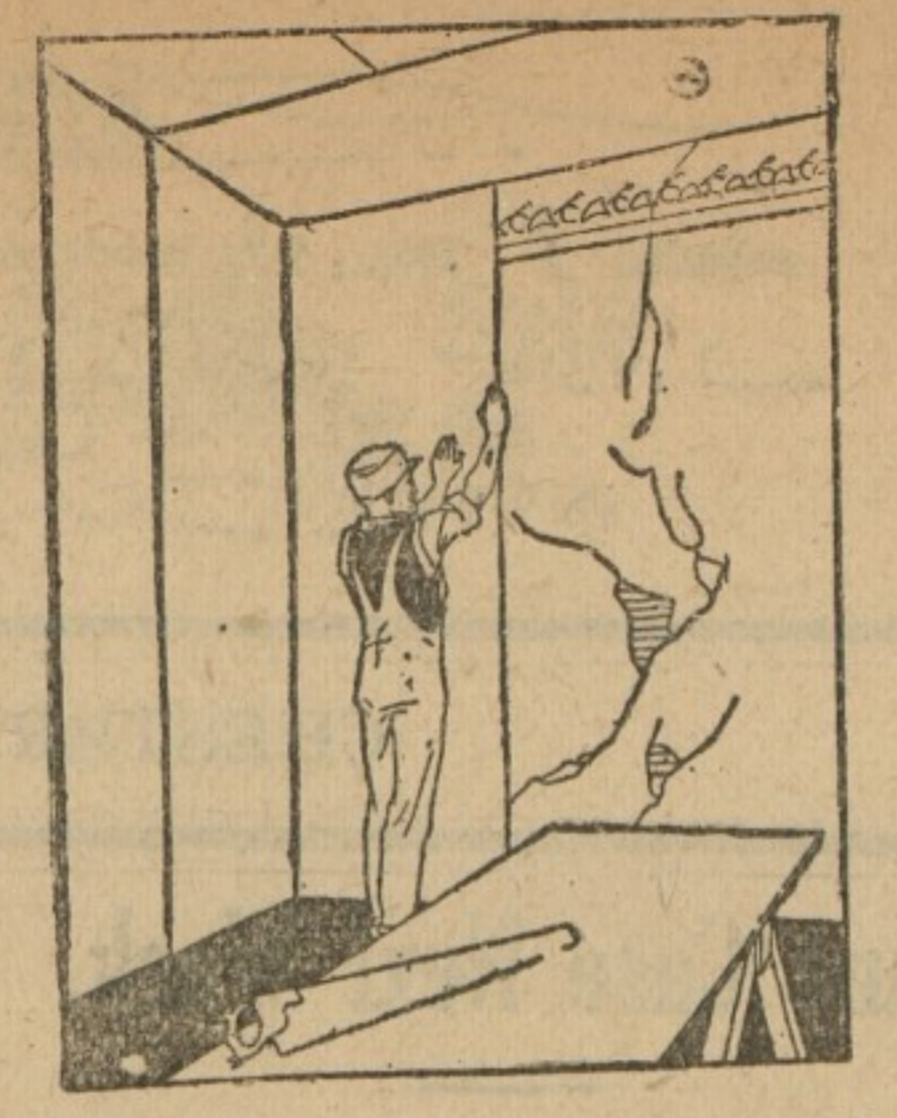

Table with columns for DAILY, Arrive, and Depart times for various stations including Washington, Philadelphia, New York, and Montreal.

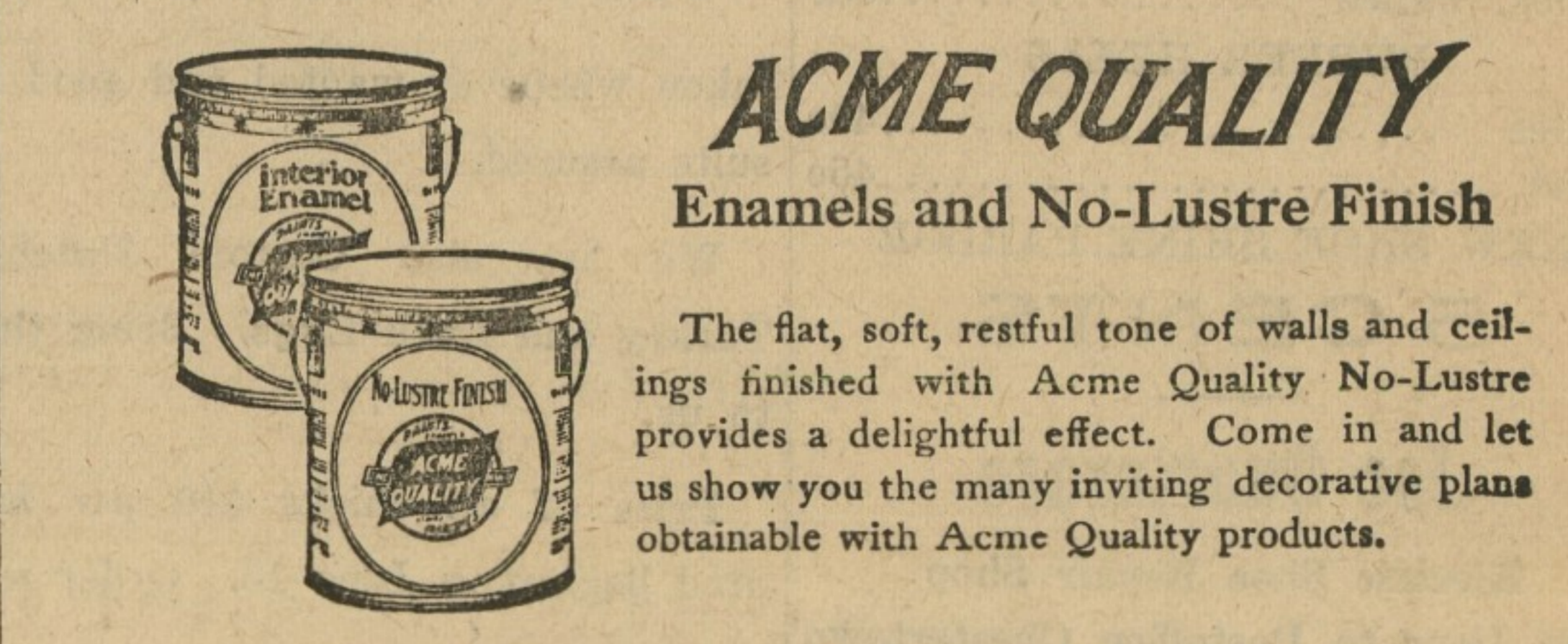

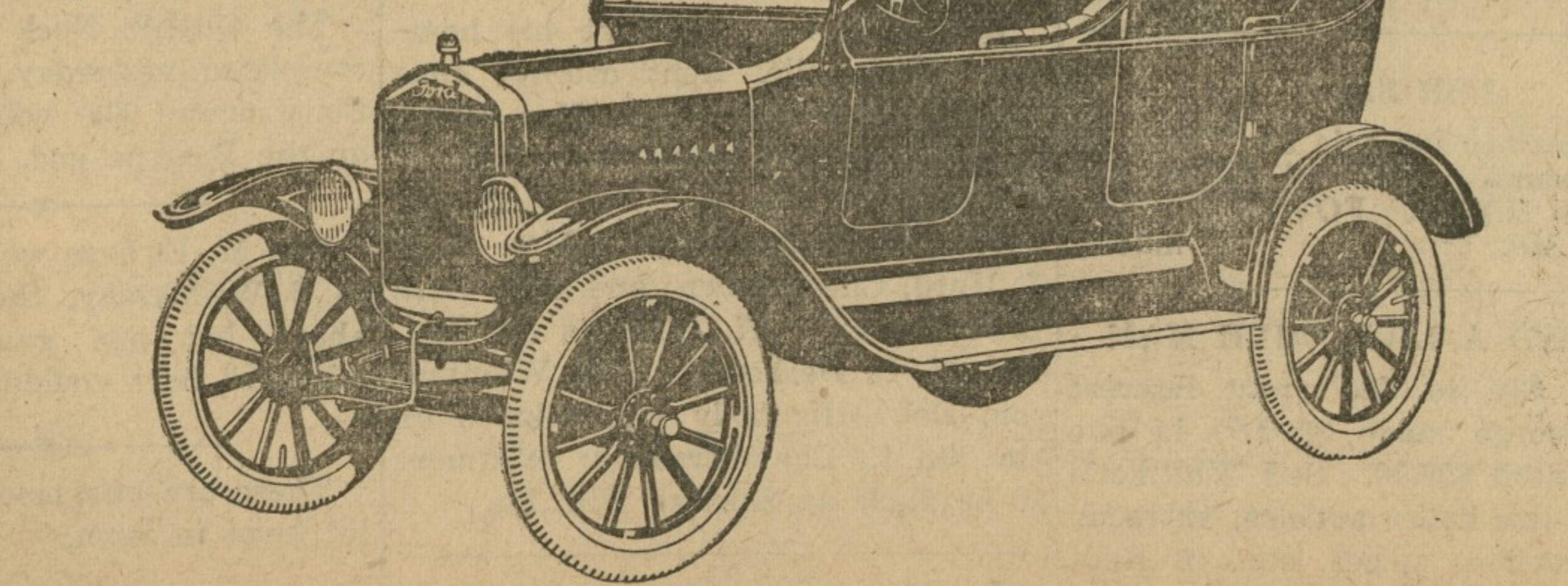

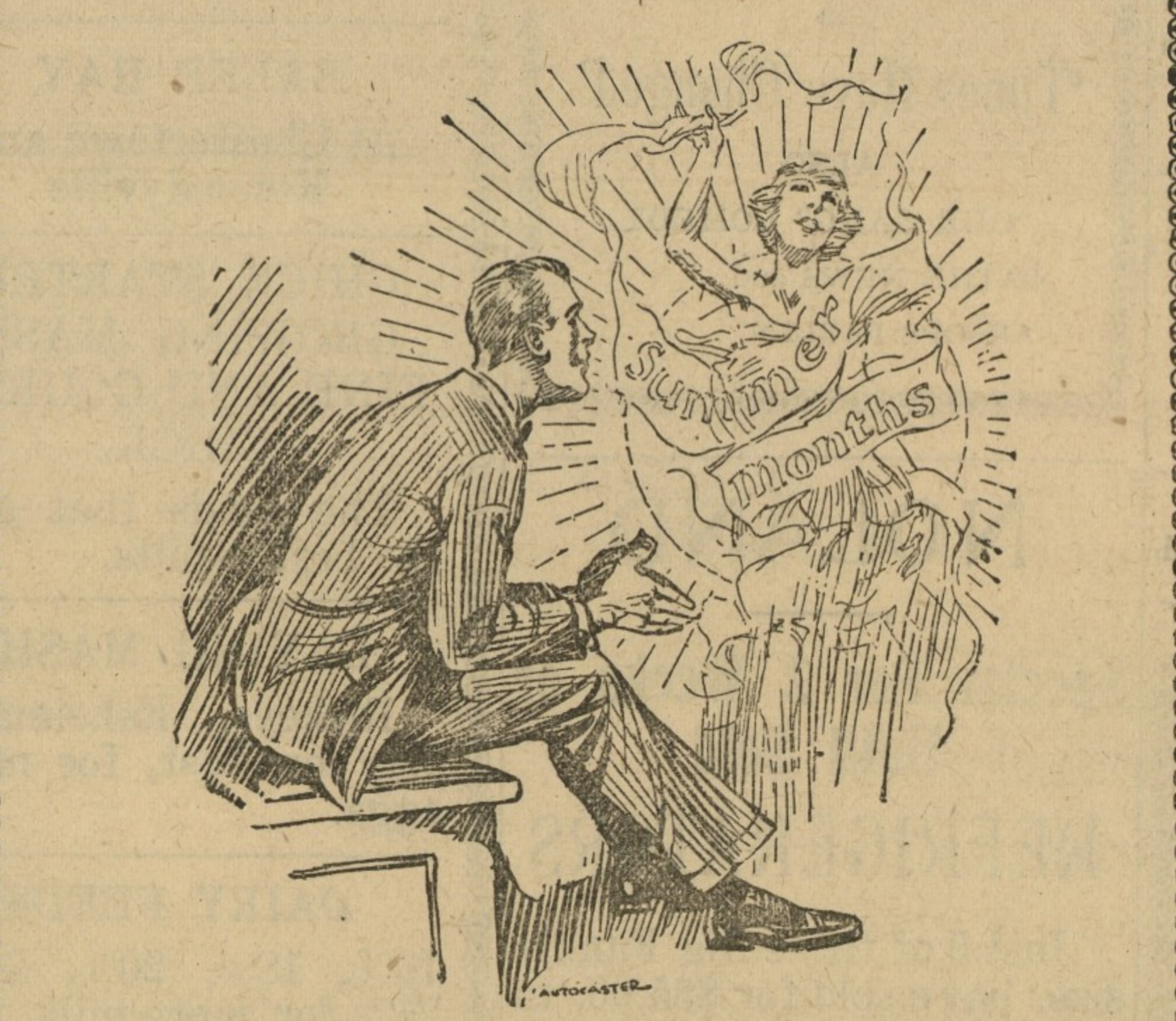
