
3 of Year's Biggest Upsets Covered Period of 8 Days

Three of the greatest upsets in the sporting world during the past twelve months came within the brief period of eight days. The first of these occurred on Sept. 16, when William T. Tilden, after holding the national tennis championship for six successive years, was defeated by Henri Cochet of France in the round before the semi-finals. The second came on Sept. 18, when Bobby Jones, after reaching the final round of the national amateur golf tourney, was defeated by George Van Elm and thus prevented from holding the title for three years in a row. The third came on Sept. 23, when Jack Dempsey, overwhelming favorite, lost his world's heavyweight championship to Gene
