

FLORIDA FROGS ARE NOT HARD TO RAISE

Government Glad To Help Start Farm-Snakeproof Fence Is Needed.

plentitude of bullfrogs that are in the fresh-water bodies in both counties. The frogs grow to monstrous size and seem to thrive in this section of the country. I think that a large and better grade of frog can be raised with proper care and I think that the raising of the frog will make a comfortable living for the man who engages in the business. "I wrote to the Department of Agriculture some months ago inquiring as to the method of raising the frog, and have received a pamphlet giving me full directions. My intention is to fence in the marsh that is on my place and start a frog farm in it... I shall get all the snakes out of the place and keep it as clean as possible, so that the frogs will be healthy at all times. I shall have the inclosure large enough to accommodate a large

number of the croakers. "I believe that there is an ample market for them in Pensacola, as all of the restaurants and hotels buy them when-Children's Strap Sandles, 75c grade, Que ever they can. The reason for the great scarcity of frogs at the present time is not that they are scarce but that they

are rather difficult to caten. "Lam. a. firm. believer in the work and shall set out with an eye to succeed. is a mudpuddle in his back yard and put some frogs in it, put a fence around it and feed the frogs. The climate is natural to them and they will thrive in spite of all efforts to exterminate them. With a little attention a large, high-grade frog can be raised."

Weather Forecast For July .- From Word and Works, by Rev. Irl R. Hicks, we obtain the following regarding the weather for the coming month: "A regular storm period covers the 1st to the 6th of July. Certain wise critics inform us that it is safe to predict warm weather in July, so we will say that very high temperature will prevail from about the 2nd to the 5th, causing a warm wave to pass eastwardly over the country on and about those days. The 4th promises rain and thunder storms for many localities. A reactionary storm period is central on the 8th, 9th and 10th. A regular storm period is central on the 14th, extending from the 12th. to the 16th. A reactionary storm period is central on the 19th, 20th and 21st. A. regular storm period is central on the 26th, extending from the 24th to the 28th. It will not be surpris. ing if threatening conditions last for several days before and after the 22nd. Heavy electrical storms and violent summer gusts are very probable about the 23rd, and from that date on through the period 24th to 28th.

Love Point to be Dumping Ground For Dredgers. - By authority of the Secretary of War, Major W. E. Craighill, of Baltimore, has designated new dumping grounds for mud and sand dredged from the bottom of Patapsco river and harbor. The old dumping grounds have been used for over 30 years. The new dumpng grounds were authorized on Major Craighill's recommendations. Two area. were authorized, one being off Swan Point, on the Kent county shore of the bay and another off Love Point. The latter has been surveyed and buoyed and hereafter all material dug up from. the bottom will be dumped there.
