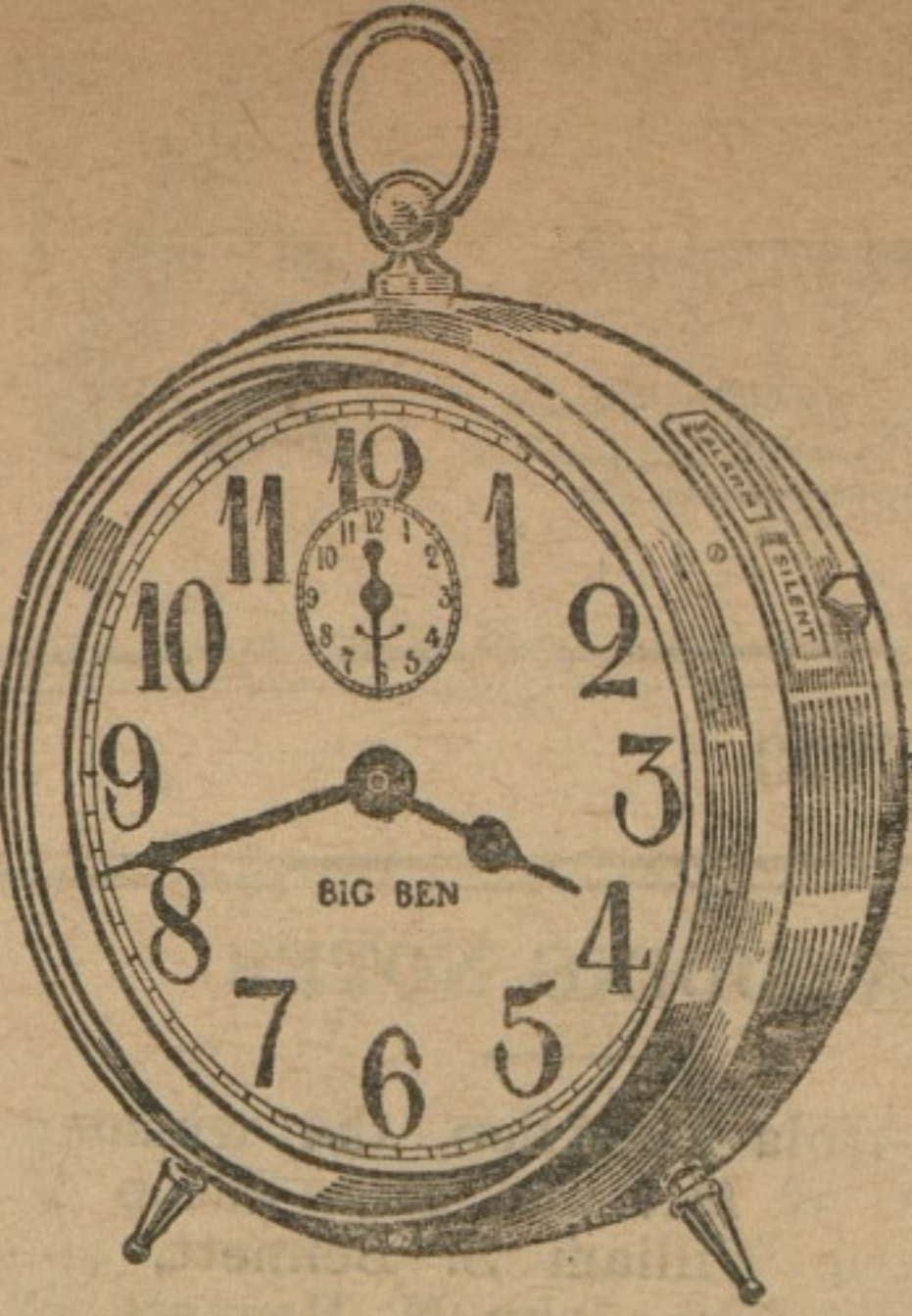

AUTOS DOWN IN PRICE

Reduction of \$40 in the price of the Ford four-door sedan and reductions in the prices of the runabout, touring car, coupe, chassis and one-ton truck were announced today by Edsel B. Ford, president of the Motor Car Company. The price of the Fordson tractor is increased \$25. No change is made in the prices of Lincoln cars and none is contemplated. The new Ford prices at the factory are: Roadster, \$265; touring, \$295; coupe, \$525; four-door sedan, \$685; chassis, \$230; truck chassis, \$370.

Substantial price reductions for Chevrolet automobiles were announced Tuesday. The new prices at the factory are as follows: Chassis, \$305; roadster, \$440; truck, \$495; utility coupe, \$640; sedan, \$795; utility truck chassis, \$560.

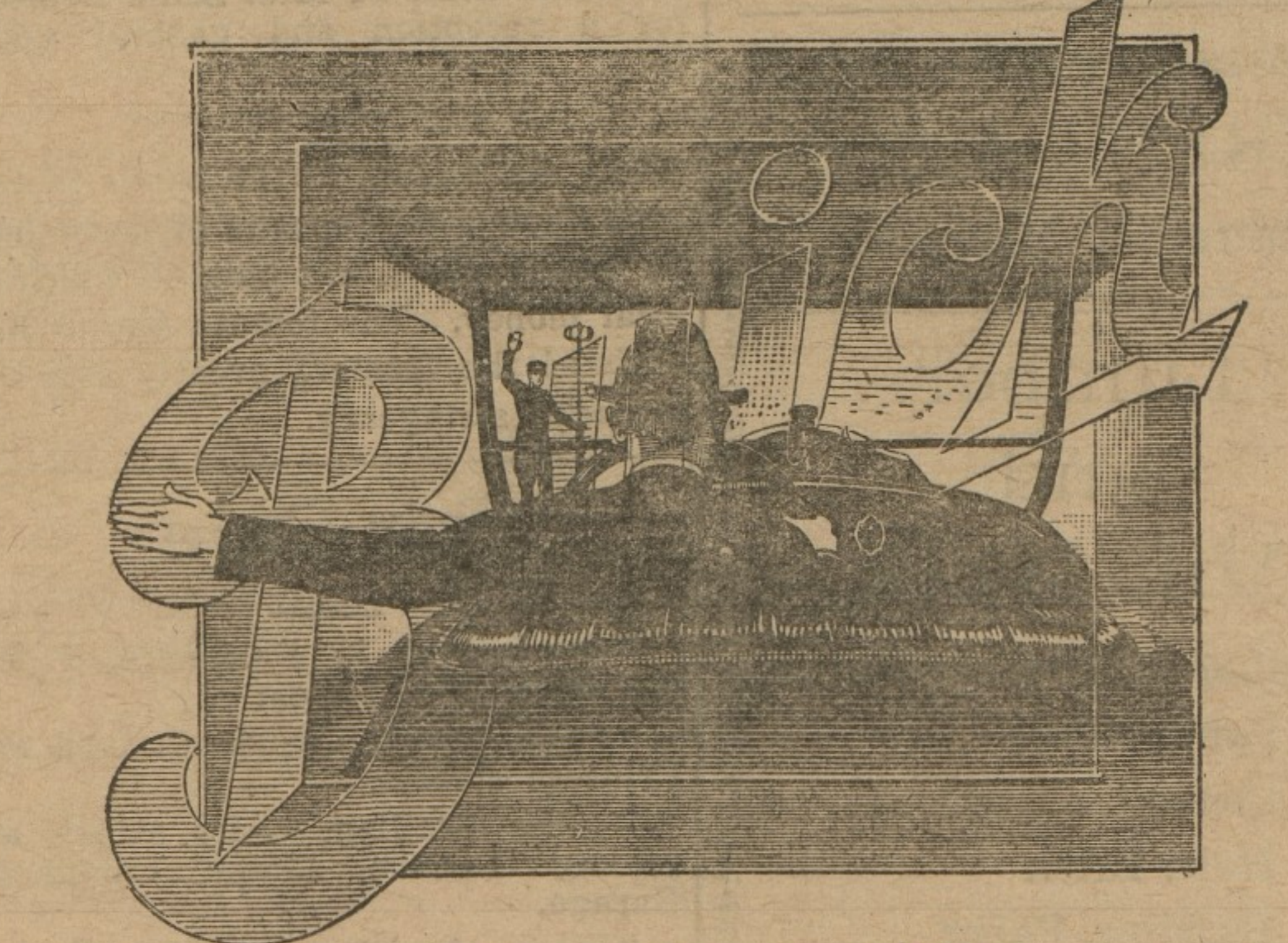
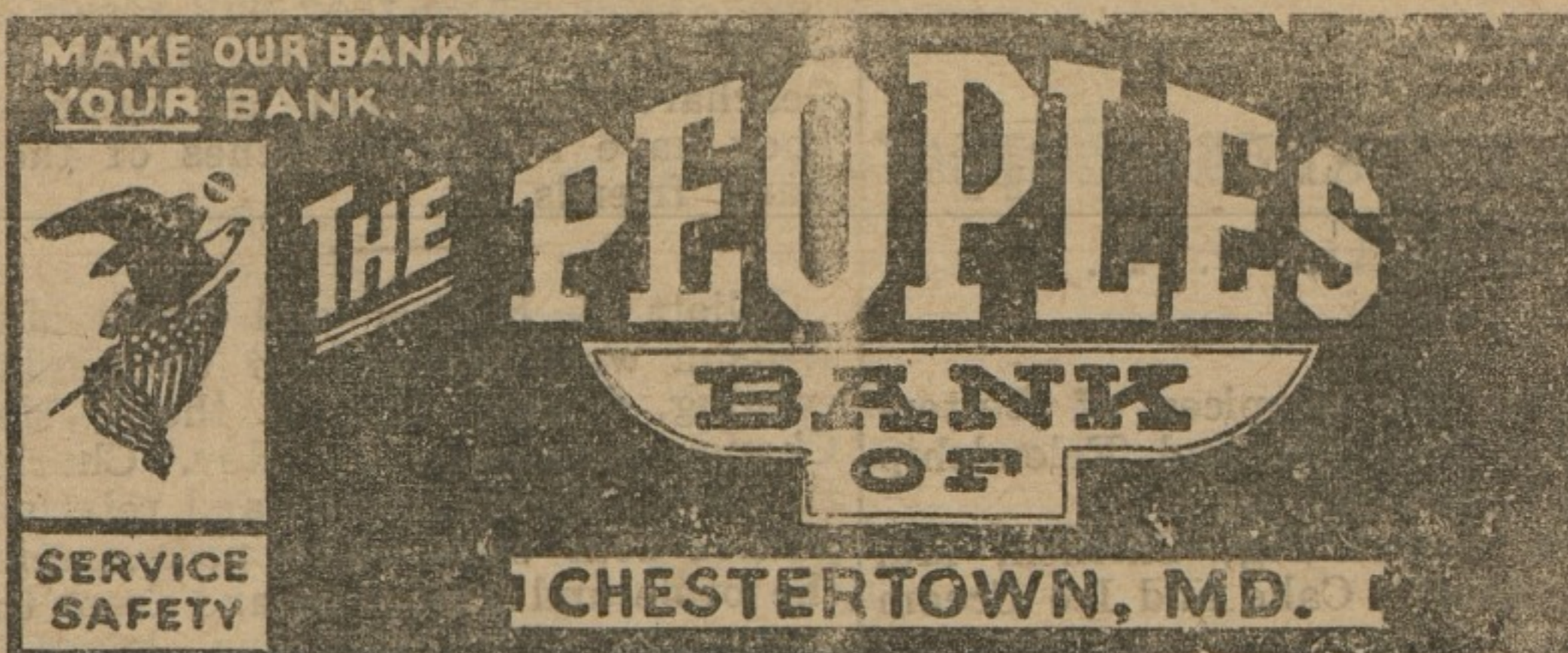
