

JAMESTOWN EXPOSITION CLOSES.

Several explanations have been offered tion, which closed Saturday. The most reasonable is that the exhibition opened in a very incomplete state, and this fact being made known throughout the counauspices. People did not relish going to inadequate accommodations were and how far from completeness the various exhibits were. Moreover, the country has become much more critical about such affairs than a few years ago, and is not at all ready to overlook shortcomings. One other thing, we believe militated against the fair; that was its inaccessibility and the fact that it was not near some great city which itself furnished a steady number of sightseers tional attraction. For instance, people liked to go Chicago and St. Louis because they had heard much of those growing metropolises, and this desire undoubtedly added greatly to the size of the crowds which visited the fairs held in them.

Of course, those of us who know the beauties of Hampton Roads and the Chesapeake Bay, who appreciate what a really fine exhibition the Jamestown fair finally became, understand what a treat we can also understand readily enough the disadvantages under which it labored. The corporation winds up business with a lamentable financial showing, being in debt to the extent of more than \$2,000,000, with assests of only problematical value. But there will be earnest hope that the Government will find some profitable use for the splendid site and have been erected upon it, thus not only saving part of the loan it made but preserving a scene of rare beauty and at-
