How Artificial Furs Are Made. The raw pieces of pelt are frozen and the skin carefully shaved off, hawed and sent to the tanneries to be made into leather. The frozen fur which remains is allowed to thaw slightly at the bottom, so that a small part of the hair is freed from ice. This thawed portion is then covered with a solution of rubber, which is allowed to set.


