And the said Joseph saith that by reason of any thing by the said William in the fourth plea of the said William above pleaded he the said Joseph from having his Execution of the Debt and Damages aforesaid against the said William of the Lands and Tenements aforesaid in the return of the writ of Scire Facias aforesaid whereof he is returned Tenant to be precluded ought not, because he saith that the said Charles Ridgely did before the Impetration of the said writ of Scire Facias assign make over and transfer unto him the said Joseph the payment aforesaid for the Debt and Damages aforesaid confessed as aforesaid by the said Rutland Mackubin and Clark in the said writ mentioned as the said Joseph by the said writ of Scire Facias hath alleged and this he prays may be inquired of by the Country, and the said William in like manner and so forth.

And the said Joseph saith that by reason of any thing by the said William in the fifth plea of the said William above pleaded he the said Joseph from having his Execution of the Debt and Damages aforesaid against the said William of the Lands and Tenements aforesaid in the return of the writ of Scire Facias aforesaid whereof he is returned Tenant to be precluded ought not, because he saith that the said Thomas Rutland did not pay unto him the said Charles Ridgely the said sum of Two thousand two hundred and ten pounds Current Money and the said Quantity of five hundred and eighty seven pounds of Tobacco Costs of suit, in manner and form of the said William hath above in his said fifth plea alleged and this he prays may be inquired of by the Country, and the said William in like manner &c.

And the said Joseph saith that by reason of any thing by the said William in the sixth plea of the said William above pleaded he the said Joseph from having his Execution of the Debt and Damages aforesaid against the said William of the Lands and Tenements aforesaid in the return of the writ of Scire Facias aforesaid whereof he is returned Tenant to be precluded ought not, because he saith that he the said Joseph did since the Confession of the said Judgment, for the Debt and Damages aforesaid pay unto the said Charles Ridgely the said Debt and Damages in the said writ of Scire Facias mentioned, in manner and form as the said Joseph by his said writ hath alleged, and this he prays may be inquired of by the Country, and the said William in like manner and so forth.

And the said Joseph saith that by reason of any thing by the said William in the seventh plea of the said William above pleaded he the said Joseph from having his Execution of the Debt and Damages aforesaid against him the said William of the Lands
