

Dr Jeffry's Myman. - Professor of Anatomy in Harvard
University; been teacher of it for 8 yrs past.

I was called with others to examine specimens found
at the Medical College. I went there on Sunday
Dec 2. I found several Medical gentlemen there. We
decided the subjects of examination. They afterwards
was mostly called to examination of the bones. I made
a catalogue of them. The box before me
contains the payments of bones found at the College
as taken from the ferman. -

My attention was not specially called to
the fleshy parts of the specimens. When I went there
they were being exp^d by Dr Lewis, Dr Stone & Gay.

This diagram was prepared to show to
what parts the bones found in the ferman
belonged. It is col^d in 3 distinct parts & one
portion. The greyish part is thorax pelvis
thigh & leg - - another portion is left ankle -
arm except in part. The colored parts
show the position of the fragments found in the
ferman. - The yellow tint shows the bones
fragments of which I found.

The specimens then are indicated
that they had been closed for purpose of
dissection. I was in some doubt
other gentlemen testified.
