"453,64 bal pd Nov 22/49" are in soft writing.

The words "of" at bottom of the l. c.
are in soft writing - The superscript
on some are in soft writing.

The amount of the 2482 note
could not have been made with a pen
or with any thing which had a point to
it. There is a trace of fibers -
