

The corpus delicti.

This consists of two propositions. 1. That Dr P is dead, and 2^o that he was killed by the voluntary agency of some other person.

It is agreed that Dr P was alive on the 23rd Nov '68 - & that in either the Medical College or had an interview then with Dr W before the hours of 1 & 2 o'clock that day.

1. To prove that he is dead - the Gov^t will ^{first} attempt to show that the remains found on the 30th Nov - in the spring & on the 1st Dec in the beach & in the furnace are parts of the dead body of Dr P.

To show this identity - Gov^t rely on the following circumstances

1. The Medical Examination, showing that the remains found correspond in size, weight, form & in the colour of the hair with Dr P.

Dr P's Am. No marks or peculiarities about them by which they can be identified.

Vide Dr Lewis - & his statements

2. The dental teeth: Especially the exact correspondence of five teeth with the mould made by Dr Vesp, & in his possession, for Dr P.
