City's Treasury or whether the Fire Department causes it to be paid by effecting an insurance and having the insurance company pay it.

The specific answer to the question in your letter of the 14th inst is that, the insurance money under Section 12 is payable directly to the member or his family, as the case may be; the payment to his family is a discharge of the obligation imposed by Section 11, and the payment to him of the \$5 per week is to be considered a part payment of his full salary provided for in Section 10, and you are advised to act accordingly.
