The Sewerage Engineer has therefore, full authority to adopt such design and construction as he may deem necessary, and the City has also the right to regulate and repair, at the expense of the owners of the property, any private sewer or drain, provided such regulation be in the interest of the public welfare. Any land owner, however, could not compel the City to protect the banks of a stream running through his property, even though the City is emptying the surface water into the stream.)
