as a truck. The policy, particularly with reference to automobiles classed as "Commercial" (which is defined as the transportation or delivery and the loading and unloading of goods or merchandise) provides that the company will be exempt from liability "as respects Body Injury to any passengers while any automobile described in the declarations as 'Commercial' is used for passenger carrying purposes regardless of whether a consideration is charged for the carrying of such passengers." I suggest, therefore, that you be particularly careful to see that no trucks or other automobiles which might come within the definition of "Commercial" as set out in the policy, are used for the purpose of carrying passengers.
