that it was the intention of the City Council in ordaining it to repeal all provisions of the pre-existing law with regard to specific exemptions from and tax credits allowable upon tuition fees and to leave these matters to be decided by the Board of Estimates upon recommendation of the Board of School Commissioners.

My information is that the Board of Estimates has never changed the schedule of tuition fees established by Ordinance No. 710, has never made any provision for the allowance of tax credits upon the tuition fees payable by parents or guardians of non-resident students and has never granted any general exemption from the payment of such fees to the children of officers and others in the service of the United States as such. It has, however, in a number of instances, upon recommendation by the Board of School Commissioners waived the tuition fees payable by certain non-resident students. The instances in which such charges have been waived will doubtless be furnished you upon request by the Board of School Commissioners.
