Dear Mr. Evans:

You have referred to me for an opinion a letter of Charles E. Bichy, Esq., Deputy Collector, in regard to whether or not dog licenses expire on May 1 or December 31 in each year.

Article 25, Section 21 of the Baltimore City Code (1927) provides as follows:

"Licenses granted under this sub-title shall date from the first day of May in each year . . ."

This language is taken from Ordinance No. 96, approved June 15, 1930, which is the last enactment of the Mayor and City Council in regard to dog licenses.
