

Mr. Leon Small, Water Engineer (cont'd)

From a legal point of view, I would prefer having specific authority from the Legislature to tap the Susquehanna River above the Conowingo Dam and to convey the water therefrom into the City, rather than to rely entirely on existing legislation. I noticed in the newspapers that the Governor may call a special session of the Legislature in January and, if you decide upon the Susquehanna River as the source of water supply to which the City should next go, I would appreciate your advising me as soon as possible in order that I, in turn, may consider the advisability of requesting the Governor to include in his special session program legislation of the character above mentioned.
