nature and assessed against property as an incident to its location.

As to Mr. Harper's statement that the Bureau of Highways paved the alley in question without notice to the Company, I advise you that the same is not borne out by the facts, as the records of the Bureau of Highways show that notices were posted at the beginning and ending of said alley on May 10, 1942, pursuant to the provisions of Article 45, Sections 117 and 118 of the Baltimore City Code (1927 Ed.).

I accordingly recommend that the claim of the cemetery company for the abatement of the alley paving charge be denied.
