On this thirteenth day of January in the
year of our Lord eighteen hundred
and thirty five before me the subscriber
one of the Justices of the Peace in and
for the said City personally appeared
John Collins and made oath on the holy
warranty of Almighty God that he was
in the employ of Pitt E Bowen as a Carter
and that in driving or passing over the
draw between the Crown Point with a
load in the cart of fifty one Bushels of
Salt, one of the Horses belonging to the
said Bowen, fell through in consequen-
ce of the Bridge giving way, being in an
condition not capable of bearing the
weight upon it, and fearing some such
accident he was particular and careful
and had hold of the Bridle of the Horse
at the time and that the accident was the
death of the horse in eleven days after
the said fall Sworn before
