 Personal be appraised & one Quarter Part thereof Give to my Daughter Hannah
 Edwards to have her heirs & assigns forever & all the rest of my Estate I give to my
 two Sons Pease Edwards & Joseph Edwards to be equally divided between the
 said Pease Edwards & Joseph Edwards to be possessed by them their heirs & assigns
 forever And I do hereby constitute & appoint Samuel Rayland to be my
 whole sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof
 I the said Joseph Edwards have to this my last Will & Testament set my
 Hand & Seal the Day & year above written

In the Name of God Amen the twentieth Day of December 1757 I Isaac Andrews of Dorchester
 County in the Province of Maryland being weak in Body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be
 given unto God therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that
 it is appointed for all men once to die Do make & ordain this my last Will &
 Testament that is to say Principally first of all Give & recommend my soul into
 the Hands of almighty God that gave it & my Body I recommend to the earth to be
 buried in decent Christian Burial at the Direction of my Regular Ministers doubting
 but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power
 of God & do touching such worldly Estate wherewith I hath pleased God to bless
 me with in this life Give devise & dispose of the same in the following manner
 I do first Give & bequeath unto my Son Joseph Andrews the Plantation where he
 now dwells with all that Tract of Land called Fergersands Forrest. I likewise
 give unto my Son Joseph Andrews one Negro Girl called Alcedino & give him
 one Leather Bed one Chair one Blanket one sheet one Pillow one Bedstead
 & bed one Table & one Chair (but onging to it now in his Possession one large oval
 Table that is now in the Possession of my Son Joseph Andrews no more of my
 Estate Real nor Personal I likewise give unto my Son Stephen Andrews and
 Isaac Andrews all that Tract of Land whereon I now dwell which I bought
 of the Mohawks called Head Range & of a Noble Division to be equally divided
 between them & their heirs of their Heirs if either of them should dye without an
 ore of their Body I put in possession my Daughter Bettye Seague Fitzganes
 of Land called the Fork lying between the small Beaver Hally & Henry
 Runnake Mine to be left in her Possession during her Natural life & at
