An Ordinance making provision for the support of Lunatic paupers in the Maryland Hospital approved 10th March 1827.

An Ordinance to regulate the inspection of Beef and Pork approved 4 March 1826, except the 14 & 15 sections.

An Ordinance directing the inspection of butter and Hogs lard approved 16 March 1826, except the Clause giving part of the fines to the informer.

An Ordinance to provide for remitting certain fines by the Mayor approved 7 April 1826, as it appears on page forty of the Ordinances of 1826.

An Ordinance relating to the grading of streets in the city of Baltimore, approved, 16 June 1826.

An Ordinance to provide for the appointment of Directors in the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company approved 29th March 1827, except the second section.

An Ordinance relative to the former County Levy approved 25 April 1821.

An Ordinance relating to the Susquehanna Rail Road, approved, 3 May 1830.

An Ordinance to insure the means of completion for the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road approved 18 April 1835.

Sec 2 And be it enacted and Ordained, that all Ordinances of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore passed before the commencement of the present session except those named in the first section of this Ordinance, and except such Ordinances and parts of Ordinances as authorize and confirm any contract or contracts, or confer on any person or persons or on any body politic, any privilege, or as give the assent of this Corporation to any act of the legislature of Maryland, or relate to opening, closing or grading any street, lane or alley, or part thereof, and except such Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, as impose any tax, any portion of which remains due and uncollected, shall be and the same are hereby repealed, saving to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, and all other persons all vested rights; and provided that such repeal shall not extend to revive any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance heretofore repealed, or to any offence committed or penalty incurred before the passage of this Ordinance; and that an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance for the appointment of a High Constable, City Bailiffs and for other purposes
