An Ordinance to create and equip an additional engine company in the Baltimore City Fire Department to be known as Engine Company No. 20.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Board of Fire Commissioners be and it is hereby authorized and directed to organize and fully equip one engine company, to be located in the engine house of the said department situated on North avenue near Tenth street; said company to be known as Engine Company No. 20.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted and ordained, That the said engine company shall consist of one captain, at an annual salary of eleven hundred dollars (\$1,100); one lieutenant, at an annual salary of one thousand dollars (\$1,000); one, engineman, at an annual salary of eleven hundred dollars (\$1,100); one assistant engineman, at an annual salary of nine hundred dollars (\$900); one hostler, at an annual salary of nine hundred dollars (\$900), and seven pipemen, at an annual salary of eight hundred dollars (\$800) each, and shall be pro-
